Supervisor Jerry Pahlman introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

**A RESOLUTION FOR THE TOWN OF CRANE LAKE REQUIRED BY THE LCCMR
COMMITTING TO THE PAYMENT OF OPERATION EXPENSES FOR THE VISITOR CENTER
BEING CONSTRUCTED**

WHEREAS, the Town of Crane Lake has developed and implemented a comprehensive plan to build a Visitor Center, Campground, and Water Access for visitors to the Voyageurs National Park, the BWCAW, the Superior National Forest, and the Quetico Provincial Park;

WHEREAS, the Town of Crane Lake has applied to the Legislative-Citizen Commission on Minnesota Resources (LCCMR) for funding;

WHEREAS, a Work Plan needs to be submitted to the LCCMR as part of the funding requirements;

WHEREAS, a commitment by the Town of Crane Lake to accept all operation and maintenance costs for the new Crane Lake Visitor Center and Campground is required as part of the LCCMR Work Plan;

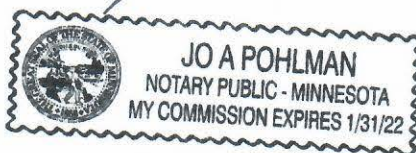
